1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the impugned document dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-8), impugned registration dated 29.03.2023 (Annexure P-9) and mutation dated 11.12.2023 (Annexure P-6).
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail their other remedies, in accordance with law.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
