1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.332 dated 19.09.2020, under Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 363, 366-A, 376(2)(a) IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel has informed that out of total 21 prosecution witnesses, 14 witnesses have already been examined by the trial Court.
3. Case has been called twice, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. 23.01.2024, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
4. It appears that the petitioner has lost interest in the present petition and he does not wish to pursue the same, as such, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
