Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to operate Battery Operated Golf Car – free of cost – for facilitating movement of passengers especially handicapped, senior citizens and other needy passengers at Chandigarh Railway Station as agreed vide letter dated 09.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents contends that the agreement in question has already outlived its total duration and any such continuation of the agreement cannot be allowed in this manner and the same can only be allowed/ allocated in a manner known to law.

Under the given circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the appropriate remedies against the respondents, if so advised and in accordance with law.
