The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking extension of Parole granted to him vide order dated 20.08.2024 passed by this Court, for the medical treatment of his father, who is stated to be suffering from acute respiratory disease.

2. It may be noticed that earlier the petitioner had filed CRWP-6418-2024 for grant of Parole on the same ground. In the said petition, a response was sought from the State and it was only after the verification of the medical condition of the petitioner's father by the State Counsel that the said petition was disposed of vide order dated 20.08.2024 thereby granting the petitioner 04 weeks' parole.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner's father, has been admitted in AAA Hospital, Jhajjar. It is further submitted that the surgery of petitioner's father had to be postponed and the same is to



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be conducted within next few days. He, therefore, seeks extension of Parole for a period of further 03 weeks.

4. The factum of medical condition of the petitioner’s father, has not been disputed by the learned State Counsel.

5. We have heard Counsel for the parties.

6. Taking into account the medical condition of the father of the petitioner, which is evident from the document Annexure P-2, we deem it appropriate to extend the Parole already granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.08.2024, for a further period of 10 days, enabling him to take care of his ailing father. The period of 10 days shall commence from 23.09.2024 i.e. the date when the parole granted earlier comes to an end. The petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 03.10.2024. After surrender, the petitioner shall furnish a surrender certificate. The State Counsel shall also file a report apprising this Court about the surrender of the petitioner.

7. With the aforesaid observations/directions, the instant petition is disposed of.

8. It is made clear that no further Parole shall be granted to the petitioner and the present extension of Parole shall be treated to be as a last indulgence.
