1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 06.05.2015 (Annexure P-1), whereby the Inspector Cooperative Societies, Dhapali, Tehsil Phul, District Bathinda had recommended to the President/Managing Committee, The Ghanda Banna Multipurpose Cooperative Societies Limited to take action as per allegation No.8 of the report vide which it was recorded that the petitioner was illegally appointed.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 21.05.2015, the operation of the impugned order was stayed.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Jatesh K. Garg, Inspector, Cooperative Societies, Dhapali, ARCS Phul, submits that since the petitioner has already submitted resignation dated 01.11.2016, which was accepted vide resolution No.2 dated 01.11.2016, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. The said fact has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
