The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioner on the post of Driver at par with his counterparts. Further prayer has been made to direct the respondent – Corporation to release the arrears of salary/backwages to the petitioner from the date of regularisation till the date of superannuation i.e. 30.04.2022, along with interest @ 12% per annum from the date the said amount is due till its actual paymet in favour of petitioner.

After arguing the case for some time, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the competent authority claiming regularization. He further submits that the petitioner shall make a representation to the respondents within a period of one month from today and the same may be ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner.



Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the competent authority within a period of three months.
