1. Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.125 dated 11.06.2020 registered under Sections 17/27-A/61 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short – NDPS Act) at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.
2. The petitioner, alongwith his co-accused, is being prosecuted for having been found in illegal possession of 11 kgs of opium; he stands convicted in 02 other cases under the NDPS Act and that in addition thereto he is facing trial in another matter registered against him under the NDPS Act.
3. In the light of the above, the petitioner, at this stage, does not deserve the concession of regular bail.
4. Dismissed.
