The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.3, whereby recovery has been ordered to be effected from the family pension of the petitioner without giving an opportunity of personal hearing to her. Further seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents not to deduct any amount from family pension of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the impugned order dated 15.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) has been withdrawn vide order dated 26.04.2024.
