1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is within selected candidates but, for the reasons owing to the petitioner's mental health, he could not accept the appointment order on the day when the same was offered, which mistake was realized by the petitioner immediately and an application was filed to grant him the appointment on the basis of his merit, which request is not being accepted by the respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the post against which the petitioner was selected is still lying vacant, respondents be directed to allow the petitioner to join the duty in pursuance to the appointment order already prepared, which was offered to the petitioner on 07.09.2024.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr.Arun Gupta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 09.09.2024, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P5 and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of three week’s from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the post has not been offered to any other candidate upto today, the claim of the petitioner will be considered against the said post.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
