By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
139	31.08.2024	191 (2), 191 (3), 190, 115 (2), 324 (2), 109, 309 (4), 309 (6) and 351 (2) of BNS, 2023.	Sector 39, Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 21.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 21.10.2024.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hirdewant Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is

neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 3 has opposed the petition on the ground that keeping in view the gravity of the offence, the petition does not deserves the concession of bail.

5. During the course of hearing on 21.10.2024, following order was passed:

“2. Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the complainant had move the representation (Annexure P-3) along with affidavits dated 04.09.2024 Annexure P-4 and Annexure P-5 intimating that the persons namely Pinky, Neha, Tarsem, Ashu and Aniket were not assailants. He contends that even the complainant have not uttered anything against the petitioners and despite that the police is raiding.

3. The learned State counsel while referring to the reply has submitted that the aforesaid representation has been received by the concerned authorities and despite being called, the complainant have not turned up. To this, learned counsel representing the complainant has reiterated that the complainant went to the police station on 15.10.2024 and were told to give the statement which was already typed and under pressure they could not sign the same and have placed on record the copy of the representation dated 15.10.2024 given in this regard to Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

4. Be that as it may be, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from today and in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the

Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

5. List on 12.11.2024.

6. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present in Court along with record on that date.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 21.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 21.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; she will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
