ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

1. **With the consent of learned counsel representing the parties RA-
CW-403-2024 in CWP-28022-2023 and RA-CW-398-2024 in CWP-28056-**

2023 shall stand disposed of by this common order.

2. The petitioners seek review of detailed judgment passed on 22.08.2024, while disposing of CWP-28022-2023 and CWP-28056-2023.

3. Both the above-mentioned writ petitions filed by the petitioners were dismissed by a detailed judgment passed on 22.08.2024.

4. Having heard learned counsel representing the parties, this Court is of the opinion that the review applications lack substance and hence, liable to be dismissed on the following ground:-

I. First of all the review is sought on the ground that the automatic messages generated by the website of Punjab Nurses Registration Council (hereinafter referred to as 'PNRC') proves that complete details of the students were available with PNRC, which proves uploading of complete information. This material was disclosed by the petitioner when attempt was made to admit the students in GNM Course for Session 2024-25. The petitioner claims that previously PNRC has stated that they do not have the information with respect to the students because their documents were not uploaded on the portal. It is submitted that the falsity in the stand of the PNRC stood exposed. He further contends that there is conflicting judgments passed by this Court in ***CWP-3467-2024, 'Mata Saraswati Institute of Nursing Education Vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 20.08.2024***, ***CWP-25215-2023, 'Satguru Institute of Nursing Education vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 23.01.2024*** and ***CWP-831-2024, 'Guru Nanak Nursing Institute Vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 24.09.2024***.

5. Detailed para-wise reply to the review applications has been filed. It has been disclosed that the Colleges run by both the petitioners' societies

only generated ID of the students but thereafter failed to upload all the

documents, which is followed by generation of challans for deposit of fee. Thus, the documents of the students were uploaded is denied by the respondent-PNRC. Hence, this Court has observed that disputed questions of facts are involved.

6. There is no discovery of new material because from the very beginning, it is stand of the PNRC that unique ID of the students was generated by the Colleges but they did not upload documents. The automatic text generated by the website only shows ID for the students was generated.

7. With regard to the second submission, it would be noticed that in the cases of Mata Saraswati Institute of Nursing Education, Satguru Institute of Nursing Education and Guru Nanak Nursing Institute are different because these institutes had uploaded the documents and generated challans, however, failed to deposit fee prior to the cut-off date, whereas, in the case of the petitioner’s Colleges, the required documents for the admission of the students were not uploaded. Hence, there is no conflict in the judgment because there is marked distinction between the case of the petitioners herein and the facts of the judgments which have been produced.

8. Reluctantly, finding no merit, both the review applications are dismissed.

9. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
