1. This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Amritsar to decide the complaint (Annexure P-1) under Section 35 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 bearing No.CC-45-2023 instituted on 25.01.2023 titled as “Sanjeev Sharma Vs. Star Health and Allied Insurance Co. Ltd and others” expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, complaint was filed by the petitioner on 25.01.2023 and the petitioner had also filed written arguments on 15.06.2023. It is further submitted that opposite party is taking dates repeatedly for filing written arguments which fact is apparent from the zimni orders. It is submitted that



in view of the same, District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Amritsar be requested to decide the case expeditiously.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present revision petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to decide the case as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of all the parties concerned before respondent No.4 are requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the case.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
