1. Vide this common order, the above-mentioned three petitions shall
stand disposed of as the parties have arrived at a settlement/compromise dated

08.11.2023 in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the parties contends that settlement/agreement dated 08.11.2023 has been arrived at between the parties in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

3. As per the settlement/agreement dated 08.11.2023 before the Mediator, the parties have mutually decided to resolve their matrimonial dispute. The petitioner-husband has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.23,50,000/- to the respondent-wife, as permanent alimony past, present and future and they have decided to withdraw all the litigations, which have been filed against each other.

4. Today petitioner-Rakesh Gosain and respondent-Srishti are present in Court. They have been interacted with by me. They have no objection if the settlement/agreement dated 08.11.2023 recorded by the Mediator, which is duly signed by them is accepted, as such, the said agreement dated 08.11.2023 is accepted.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner in CRR(F)-363-2016 intends to withdraw the present petition wherein the challenge was to the order passed by the trial Court in petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. The present revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn being compromised.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners in CRM-M-35540-2015 seeks to withdraw the present petition in terms of the settlement between the parties, as such, CRM-M-35540-2015 stands dismissed as withdrawn.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner in CRM-M-40628-2017 seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition on the basis of settlement between the parties, as such, CRM-M-40628-2017 stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
