Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.60 dated 26.06.2023 registered under Sections 323/324/498-A/ 34 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Division IV, District Ludhiana.

2. Report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, as per which an amicable settlement/agreement has been arrived at between the parties. Written settlement has also been annexed with this report as Annexure-A, which be tagged at the appropriate place of this petition.

3. Vide order dated 11.01.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

4. Learned State counsel on instructions has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 18.01.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.01.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
