1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is undergoing treatment at PGIMER, Chandigarh and has been transferred from Dugri to Rupnagar, which is causing prejudice to him.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 24.08.2024, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation has been received from the petitioner, the same will be considered and an appropriate order on the same will be passed by the authorities within a period of two weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible, the request of the petitioner will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be given while passing the order on the representation for not accepting the request of the petitioner and the same will be conveyed to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
