Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.  
in case bearing FIR No. 201 dated 17.09.2022 under Sections 498-A, 406,  
420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

On 02.05.2024 following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel has confirmed that though the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of the order passed by this Court, however, while referring to the status report by way of affidavit of Bhupinder Singh Bhullar, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, District Moga dated 17.07.2023 as well as the bank statements appended along with the said status report, it has been pointed out that the complainant has taken loan amounting to Rs. 6 Lakhs on 10.02.2021 and further taken another loan of Rs.8,17,973/-. The said amount was utilised by the petitioner as there are entries in the accounts regarding transfer of Rs. 6 Lakhs on 22.02.2021 and Rs. 2,50,000/- on 15.02.2021. It was also

pointed out that first entry regarding the transfer of Rs. 2,50,000/- on 15.02.2021 was to clear the loan taken by the petitioner from the Finance Company and the dowry articles are also not recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks accommodation to have instructions with regard to the said entries.

Adjourned to 23.05.2024.

In the meantime, petitioner may file response to the said entries.

Interim order to continue till the next date of hearing.”

On the last date of hearing, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has informed that the challan has been presented.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
