1. The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.127, dated 22.11.2023, registered under Sections 380, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise/Affidavit dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at, between the parties.

2. In compliance of the order dated 25.09.2024, report has been received from learned JMIC Baghapurana (Duty). As per the report, the parties failed to arrive at an amicable settlement since the complainant/respondent gave a categoric statement before the Court concerned that he would want to pursue the case at hand against all the accused/petitioners.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent No.2 has also opposed the prayer made in the instant petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise since the parties have not been able to arrive at an amicable settlement.

4. In view of the above, the present petition for quashing the aforesaid FIR is dismissed.
