1. In pursuance of last order, compliance affidavit of Mr.K.Makrand Pandurang, IAS, Director General, Information, Public Relations & Languages Department, Haryana, Chandigarh, has been filed on behalf of the respondents in Court today, which is taken on record. As per the same, the petitioners stand regularized. It further contains that the arrears payable to the petitioners shall be released by 26.11.2024.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition any further.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
