Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 23.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, declaring petitioner a proclaimed offender in FIR No.77 dated 22.03.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana, Punjab.

2. At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has complied with the order dated 05.10.2023 and handed over a copy of the zimni order which reads as follows:-

“File put up today on application for furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds in compliance of order dated 05.10.2023 passed by the Hon’ble High Court in CRM-M-50265 of 2023. Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished, same are accepted and attested. Papers be attached with the main filed and put up on date fixed i.e. 28.11.2023.

3. Counsel appearing for respondent No.2 submits that main matter already stands compromised and they are in process of filing quashing petition of main FIR.

4. Since the parties have already settled their main matter and the petitioner furnished bonds before the trial Court and is appearing continuously, as such, order dated 23.11.2016 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner was declared proclaimed person, is set aside and quashed. Petition stands allowed. All pending application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of.
