eight other co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail by the trial Court.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner. However, she admits that the petitioner is the first offender and was not involved in any other criminal activity earlier.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 29.05.2024 and after completion of the investigation, challan has already been presented against him. Apart from that, all other co-accused have been ordered to be released on bail by the trial Court. Thus, further detention of the petitioner as under-trial prisoner in the present case is not required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
