1. This is the petitioner's seventh attempt to get bail during the pendency of the trial arising from FIR No.15 dated 06.12.2017, under Sections 21/29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 18/25, Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 added later on) Police Station S.T.F., Phase-4, Mohali.

2. Learned counsel representing the parties are *ad idem* that the prosecution as well as defence have already concluded their evidence and the case is now fixed for final arguments. However, it has been submitted that accused, namely, Baldev Singh @ Raja and Simran Kaur have not been produced by the Jail Authorities resulting in adjournment.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harwinder Singh has submitted that all the three accused, namely, Manoj Kumar, Baldev Singh @ Raja and Simran Kaur shall be physically produced before the Court on the

next date of hearing i.e. 10.11.2024.
