1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to submit the final report in the FIR No.273 dated 26.08.2021, under Sections 3, 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala (Annexure P-1).
2. Today, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG Punjab on instructions from ASI Naveen Kumar informs the Court that investigation is now complete and final report is pending for approval before the Competent Authority, which is likely to be filed to the Competent Court within a period of ten days from today.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has endorsed no objection for disposing the present petition, in view of the undertaking given by learned State counsel.
4. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed off, since no cause of action survives in view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel.
5. In case, the State fails to adhere to its undertaking given before this Court, the petitioner will be at liberty to move an application for revival of the instant petition.
