Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), a prayer is made for grant of relief of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.28, dated 05.02.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 21 (b) (ii) (C)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station District Charkhi Dadri.
2. Custody Certificate dated 27.09.2024, qua the petitioner, furnished by learned State counsel today, in the Court. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

There is no supervening or changed circumstances in the instant matter, after the first regular bail application, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure-P-3), and without waiting further for the process of trial, the instant petition has been filed, within a period of two months approximately. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
