The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.100 dated 20.07.2023 registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the mediation has been failed and the petitioners have joined investigation in compliance of the order dated 06.10.2023 to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
