By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS,
2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as
under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
29	29.03.2024	420 and 406 of IPC	Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance
to the order dated 04.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has
already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the
interim bail granted vide order dated 04.10.2024 .

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dharampal
intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is
neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial
interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 04.10.2024, following order was passed:

“1. Status report by way of affidavit of Ajay Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, Punjab dated 03.10.2024 on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who seeks time to go through the same and address arguments.

2. List on 11.11.2024.

3. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate with the same. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 04.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 04.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
