1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in complaint dated 28.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) as well as complaint dated 11.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) from some higher police officials. Further prayer has been made to issue direction to respondent No.3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner at the instance of respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that complaint dated 28.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) as well as complaint dated 11.09.2024 (Annexure P-4) were given to official respondent No.2, Superintendent of Police, Kaithal but no action has been taken upon the same.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Karan Sharma, DAG, Haryana has appeared in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

5. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the complaints made by him to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal are directed to be decided expeditiously.
6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, Superintendent of Police, Kaithal is directed to decide the representation of petitioner expeditiously and not later than two months and to ensure safety of petitioner and further to ensure that no harm is caused to him.
