VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 31.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) whereby the application seeking attachment and sale of immovable property of the Judgment Debtor has been allowed and warrants of attachment have been issued.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had moved an application dated 17.07.2024 vide which the petitioner had submitted that he would deposit an amount of Rs.90 lacs and was also ready to deposit the balance amount within a period of 30 days. Reference has been made to order dated 20.07.2024 in order to show that an amount of Rs.90 lacs had been paid by the petitioner to the respondent. It is



further submitted that an application was filed by the decree holder for calculation of the total amount due to the decree holder to which the petitioner had already filed a reply and the said application was listed for 26.07.2024 and in spite of four dates, same has not been adjudicated. It is submitted that the said application is now pending for 09.10.2024.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a limited prayer that the Executing Court be directed to decide the said application regarding calculation so that the petitioner can satisfy the decree and residential house of the petitioner which had been attached, can be released to him.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present revision petition is disposed of with a request to the Executing Court to decide the application filed by the decree holder for calculation of the total amount due, to which a reply had already been filed by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month from 09.10.2024 which is stated to be the next date of hearing.

5. Counsel appearing on behalf of all the parties concerned before the Executing Court are also requested to fully assist the Court in expeditious disposal of the said application.
