KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, a prayer is made for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3, to submit the status report, in case FIR No.23, dated 04.02.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 448, 511 and 120-B of the IPC, 1860 (Sections 448 and 511 excluded, and offence under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the IPC, 1860, was added later on) vide DDR No.40, dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-2), registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him, by ASI Bharat Singh, informs this Court, that a cancellation report in the instant matter, has already been filed on dated 04.07.2024, before the learned trial Court, concerned, and the same has also been accepted.
3. In view of the above, at this stage, considering the facts, which are informed by the learned State counsel, no further direction is required to



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be passed, as sought in the instant petition.

4. Accordingly, the instant petition is **dismissed**.
5. However, liberty is reserved for the petitioner, to raise all such pleas, before the learned trial Court concerned, which are raised before this Court, before the learned trial Court concerned, who shall pass an appropriate order, within the parameters of the law.
