RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.11.2021 passed in CRM-M-47321-2021.
2. The record shows that the present petition was filed for alleged violation of the interim order dated 11.11.2021 passed in CRM-M-47321-2021.
3. Counsel for the State has produced copy of order dated 14.12.2021 whereby the above-said petition has already been finally disposed of, on the assertion made by the learned State counsel that the State was in the process of filing the cancellation report.

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4. Counsel for the State has submitted that cancellation in the FIR in question has already been filed before the concerned Magistrate on 05.02.2024.

5. In view of the above, there is nothing which survives in the present petition.

6. Dismissed.

7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
