1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus read with Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for directing the official respondents to release the detainee namely Bikramjeet Singh s/o Joginder Singh, who has been taken away illegally by respondents No.3 and 4 from his flat No.3384, Sector 51-D, Chandigarh, as since 18.09.2024 the detainee is in illegal custody of the respondents No. 3 and 4 by appointing warrant officer. Further prayer has been made for releasing the detainee with immediate effect as he is in the illegal custody of the respondents No. 3 and 4.
2. Notice of motion in the present petition was issued on 23.09.2024.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.H.O. Hapreet Singh, PS Laduwal, District Ludhiana has submitted that the alleged detainee in the present case is an accused in FIR No.62 dated 20.08.2024

under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Laduwal, District Ludhiana and presently she is in police custody.

4. In view the above, the present petition is disposed of. However, petitioner would be at liberty to pursue her remedies as available to her under the law.
