1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.145 dated 01.06.2024, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 506 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.
2. Vide order dated 25.09.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 25.09.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 25.09.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
6. Petition stands allowed.
