The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.472, dated 12.07.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118 (2), 191 (2), 190, 351 (3) of BNS, registered at Police Station HMT Hisar, District Hisar (Annexure P-1).
