1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the balance payment of Rs.6,51,485/- including security and earnest money deposited qua the work of providing and installing 1 No. new Tubewell (size 300MM x 200MM Depth up to 450M) including the cost of pumping machinery, CI Fitting, Chlorination Plant, etc. at Phase-6 and Phase-9, SAS Nagar (Mohali) executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said legal notice.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who by virtue of his assignment is also on the panel of all the statutory corporations and



bodies of the Government of Punjab, is directed to accept the notice and he accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.6, and submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.4-The Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Division No.2, Near Ranbaxy Industry, Water Works, Industrial Area Phase-1, SAS Nagar (Mohali), is directed to consider and decide legal notice dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

6. Learned counsel for respondents have no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.4-The Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Division No.2, Near Ranbaxy Industry, Water Works, Industrial Area Phase-1, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to consider and decide the legal notice dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Needless to mention that upon considering the said legal notice, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.



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9. In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum to be paid to the petitioner and subject to additional payment of a cost of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund (PPWF) of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh. The said additional financial liability of accrued interest and cost shall be subject to recovery from the erring official.

10. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
