1. Instant third petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
816	29.10.2020	Sadar, Karnal	377, 506 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act

2. After addressing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as most of the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is in detention since 01.11.2020, a direction be issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

3. Learned State counsel, who has filed the custody certificate dated 10.04.2024, upon instructions from SI Nafe Singh submits that 16 out of 18 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the remaining 2 witnesses have been summoned for 19.04.2024. He has specific instruction

to state that victim as well as his parents have been examined.

4. I have considered the request made by counsel for the petitioner.
5. Noticing the length of custody of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a request to the trial Court to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 6 months from the date of receiving of communication of this order.
