Application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for withdrawal of main case

Main case

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for
quashing of FIR No. 163 dated 17.06.2017 under Section 186, 353, 506, 332 read
with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3(1) (x) of the Scheduled
Caste and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short
'SC/ST Act'), registered at P.S. PGIMS, Rohtak (Section 333 of IPC added and
Section 3 (1) (x) of SC/ST Act deleted later on) along with consequential
proceedings pending before learned trial Court on the basis of compromise dated
11.09.2023 (P-2) arrived at between the parties.

- (2) In view of order of even date i.e. 05.02.2024 passed in CRM-4752-2024, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
- (3) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
- (4) The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
