3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satya Pal Jain, ASGI with Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, Advocate for respondent No.1-UOI, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UOI and submits that in case, the demand notice dated 10.08.2023 (Annexure P-11) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be conveyed to the State of Punjab for the implementation of the same, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent No.1, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
