disbursement thereof, he assures the Court that the same would be done
within a period of two weeks from today.

[6] However, in case the needful is not done within a period of two weeks, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
