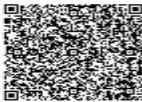
RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Article 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.05.2021 passed in CWP-4901-2020.

2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 21.05.2021 passed in CWP-4901-2020 has been complied with and speaking order dated 16.12.2022 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.



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5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
