1. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner restricts the claim of the present petition only to the extent that the period i.e. from 08.04.2015 to 31.12.2015 during which he has performed his duties on a higher post of Assistant Engineer on current duty charge basis, he is entitled for grant of salary.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has stated that to the aforesaid extent the petitioner is certainly entitled for grant of salary for the post on which he has worked for the aforesaid period and therefore, the present petition may be disposed of in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in **CWP-32192-2019** titled as “**Sanjeev Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others**”, decided on 15.02.2024.
3. In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is disposed of in same terms as that of the aforesaid judgment passed in ***Sanjeev Kumar’s case (supra)***.
