KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction, holding that the petitioner has become entitled to be released, and the detention of the petitioner is violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution.
2. Reply by way of affidavit dated 07.02.2024 of Sh. Rahul Raja, Officiating Superintendent Central Jail has been filed on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the opposite counsel.
3. As per the reply, the application for premature release of the

petitioner has been rejected vide order date 20.11.2023, which is attached with reply as Annexure R-1.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to challenge the order of premature release.
5. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make challenge to the order (supra).
