Counsel for the petitioner submits that being aggrieved by the inaction on part of the respondents No.4 to 5, the petitioner submitted complaint/representation dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana but the police authorities have failed to take any action against respondents No.6 & 7, who are already declared proclaimed offenders in a criminal case having Fir No.190 dated 21.09.2006 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, which was registered at the instance of the present petitioner.

3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on



behalf of respondents No.3 to 5 and on instructions from ASI Prem Chand submits that in case, any such complaint/representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner is pending, the same will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.

In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana to consider and decide representation dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
