GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The prayer in the present criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner endangered at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7, because they want to grab the property of the petitioner by giving threats and causing harm to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated 16.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) was given to official respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali but no action has been taken against respondents Nos.4 to 7 so far.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Manjot Kaur, AAG, Punjab has appeared in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

5. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the representation made by him to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to be decided expeditiously.
6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to decide the representation of petitioner expeditiously and not later than one month and to ensure safety of petitioner and further to ensure that no harm is caused to him.
