AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Amritpal Singh and Manjit Kaur filed instant petition for protection of their life and liberty alleging that they are in live-in relationship. They apprehend threat from respondent No.3 who is father of petitioner No.1 and from respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.2. Regarding petitioner No.2 it is further mentioned that earlier she was married and a petition for decree for dissolution of marriage is still pending.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State/respondent Nos.1 and 2. He has placed on record one report dated 21.10.2024 along with statements of both petitioners stating that now they do not have any apprehension of threats nor they want any security.

3. In view of the aforesaid statement, present petition seeking protection of life and liberty has rendered infructuous and it stands disposed of.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
