On 13.05.2024, following order was passed:-

"On 07.02.2024 the following contention was noticed:-

“xxx xxx xxx

Learned State counsel submits that the fact stands verified and indeed the petitioner is in family way and is due for delivery on 10.03.2024.

In view of above, present petition seeking release of petitioner on interim bail is allowed.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail forthwith subject to the satisfaction of the jail authorities. During the aforesaid period the petitioner shall bound by the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.*
- (ii) The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.*
- (iii) The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.*
- (iv) The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.*

- (v) *The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the trial Court.*
- (vi) *The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.*
- (vii) *The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.*

Adjourned to 13.05.2024.

Petitioner shall surrender back to the concerned jail authorities within three days.

Adjourned to 28.05.2024”.

Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of the Court that the petitioner despite there being direction on 13.05.2024 to surrender back to the concerned jail authorities within three days, has not been complied with the same.

Learned State counsel to ensure that the petitioner be arrested forthwith.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
