1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 27.07.2023 passed in CRWP-1750-2022.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the plea of the petitioner for pre-mature release already stands rejected by passing a specific order. Not only that, the petitioner has even challenged the said order by filing another petition before this Court.
3. The aforesaid facts have not been disputed by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
