There is a delay of 507 days in filing and 230 days in refiling of the instant appeal. The only reason forthcoming from the application filed seeking condonation of delay of 507 days in the filing of the appeal is that during such period the appellant was unable to decide as to whether he should or not prefer the instant appeal.

The afore reason given by the appellant is unacceptable for condoning the inordinate delay of 507 days in filing of the appeal.

In the light of the above, the applications seeking condonation of delay in filing and refiling of the appeal are dismissed. Consequent to the same, the instant appeal is also dismissed being time barred.
