1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to enquire the matter on the representation of the petitioner dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-2), filed against the private respondents.
2. As per the representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-2), the accused were threatening the petitioner-complainant after they have been relased on bail in FIR No.73 dated 20.04.2020, under Sections 376, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.
3. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 09.03.2024, by way of affidavit of Sh. Raj Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, which is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel contends that the trial in the said FIR No.73 has been concluded by way of acquittal of the private respondent No.5, as per the judgment dated 01.05.2024, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track



Court), Amritsar. Copy of the said judgment has been submitted in the Court today, which is taken on record.

5. I have considered the aforesaid contentions and also perused the status report filed on behalf of the State.

6. Along with the status report, detailed report dated 14.12.2023 was submitted, wherein, it was mentioned that enquiry in the representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) was conducted through ASI Balwinder Singh, wherein, the allegations levelled by the petitioner against the private respondents were not found to be correct.

7. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

8. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
