The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent Department to grant salary and dearness allowance along with other benefits as per 6th Pay Commission, as respondent No. 4 is also drawing the salary as per 6th Pay commission.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana,



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accepts notice, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of two weeks, the same will be decided by the second respondent-Director Secondary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receiving a certified copy of this order.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
