The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who have got married on 04.10.2023, at the hands of private respondents.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit dated 29.07.2024 of Sh. Ankur Gupta, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. In the status report, the following has been stated :-

“5. That it is submitted that from the perusal of the complete record as well as the report of the then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Shahkot, Jalandhar (Rural) the following points have come on record, which are mentioned here in below for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court:-

(a) That it has been found that, during the enquiry the petitioners i.e. Mandeep Kaur (household lady) and Ravi



Kumar (works as Mason) were made to join the enquiry and their statements were got recorded, whereby they stated that they filed the present petition for getting protection from the family of Mandeep Kaur after getting married, as they were in love with each other and now they do not face any threat and does not want any police protection. That they further stated that they do not want any action on their representation i.e. Annexure P-5. Statements of both the Petitioners i.e. Mandeep Kaur and Ravi Kumar are attached herewith as Annexure R-1/T and Annexure R-2/T respectively.

(b) That similarly, the private Respondents No. 4 to 6 i.e. Harjinder Kaur, Shinderpal and Rano were made to join the enquiry and their statements were recorded, whereby they stated that their girl Mandeep Kaur did love marriage with Ravi Kumar as per her own wish and will and after getting married, she filed the present petition against her brother Shinder Pal and sister Rano, but they did not have any objection in regard to their marriage, nor they interfere in their married life in any way. They never gave any threat to them or threatened them. They can live wherever they want in their married life.

6. That it is submitted that the enquiry conducted, it has been found that as per the statements of petitioners they do not want any police protection, as they do not face any threat. That further, they stated that they have not got any threat or have been threatened by anyone, thus, they do not want any action in regard to the present writ petition filed before this Hon'ble Court."

4. In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
