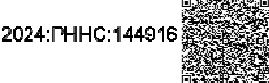

This petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a direction to the respondents to correct the error/mistake in final result for the post of TGT Sanskrit, as petitioners have been selected in Mewat cadre despite giving first preference for Rest of Haryana cadre, in response to advertisement 2 of 2023, dated 21.02.2023, and issue appointment letters to them in Rest of Haryana cadre in their respective categories as per merit.

2. Learned State counsel contends that as per the original record of selection, petitioners No.1 to 20 and 22 gave first preference for Rest of Haryana cadre and secured more marks than those of last recommended candidates in their respective categories. Petitioner No.21, Suman Devi, also gave her first preference for Rest of Haryana cadre, but has secured 72.20 marks, which are equivalent to the marks secured by the last selected candidate under unreserved category. Accordingly, appropriate decision in her case will be taken by the Commission within three weeks based on her date of birth.



3. In view thereof, the Commission is directed (i) to recommend petitioners No.1 to 20 and 22, who shall be appointed by the Department as TGTs in Rest of Haryana cadre in their respective categories as per merit, subject to their fulfilling the requisite conditions, and (ii) to take appropriate decision with regard to recommendation and appointment of petitioner No.21 keeping in view her date of birth. The appointment shall be given with all notional service benefits from the date other selected candidates pursuant to the advertisement in question have been appointed. The directions shall be carried out by the respondents within three weeks of receiving a certified copy of the order.

4. Disposed of.
